Sultan Xusho, chairwoman of WJAS, reports:

„In the current political situation, the very existence of women is at stake. We do not want radical Islam and old patriarchal traditions to rule in Syria, as these oppress women massively. For over 10 years, we have been doing valuable work in the field of women's rights.“

The diverse work encompasses all aspects of women's lives: educational and training structures have been successfully established, basic healthcare provided, pedagogical concepts developed, an orphanage built and operated, language and literacy courses offered, and reintegration work carried out with relatives of imprisoned IS perpetrators. Emergency aid has been organized for internally displaced persons and earthquake victims. All these initiatives break new ground and keep in mind the goal of a society in which women can live freely and in which ethnic and religious minorities are protected – both in the structures of the staff as in the content provided. Shared responsibility and collaborative work aim at economic security and independence in women's thinking. Traditional patriarchal structures are being carefully challenged and countered with an ethic of community.



The social model in north and east Syria is under threat.

Since the end of 2024, there have been renewed displacements and occupation. Several waves of massacres have been carried out against Alawites and Druze. The Kurdish population and other minorities are also threatened. People are living in uncertainty. The risk of a relapse into authoritarian structures is high.

WJAS's central task is to empower women and encourage them to stand up for their interests. Plans are underway to expand its work throughout the country. An office has already been opened in Damascus.
